Parking at Royer Park



Construction has begun on a major project by the City of Roseville that affects parking around the Veterans' Hall at Royer Park. A large portion of the parking lot is closed. If you are unable to find parking in the parking lot or on Park Dr., there are alternative parking areas.

The surface parking lot on Oak Street is available for use by the public until Tuesday, June 19.

Please use other public parking facilities in the area, including the Vernon Street parking garage, Saugstad Park parking lot, and the new Oak Street parking garage anticipated to open in late June.

The 'y' in signs reading 'ye olde..' is properly pronounced with a 'th' sound, not 'y'.
